- Core foundation teachers in grades 9–12 whose departmental by-grade cumulative gain indices are less than or equal to -2.0 across all grades for each core foundation subject they teach will not be considered for any award in Strands I and III.
- Core foundation teachers in Pre-Kindergarten to Second grade whose campus' third-grade cumulative gain indices in Reading and Math are less than or equal to -2.0 will not be considered for any award in Strands I and III.
- Special education core foundation teachers whose campus cumulative gain indices are less than or equal to -2.0 across all core foundation subjects they teach will not be considered for any award in Strands I and III.

* For Special Education teachers in grades 3–8 where a value-added report cannot be generated or grades 9–12 with fewer than 7 TAKS or TAKS-accommodated students. All other Special Education teachers will be considered under the respective core instructional category according to the position eligibility rules.
