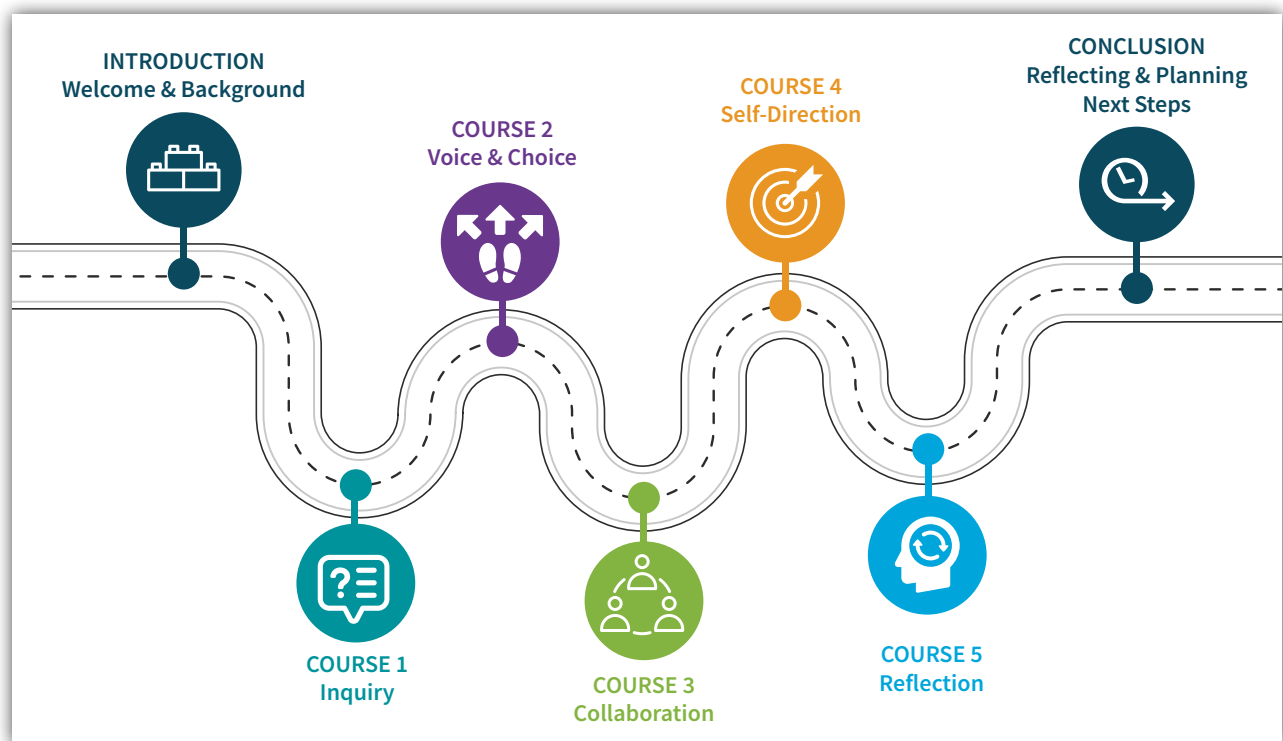
What is the Learning Schedule?
