NEW Pathway to Teacher Preparation OPPORTUNITY for Ohio Appalachian and Rural Students

Muskingum University in partnership with Battelle for Kids is piloting a new program—the Ohio Appalachian Teaching Fellowship (OATF)—that will provide a small group of regionally selected high school seniors, and/or community college students who have completed courses for college credit, an opportunity to participate in a new teacher preparation program.

- Opportunity to be a part of a program that has the potential to expand and enrich the vision of teacher preparation for the future

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Have completed courses for college credit
- Wish to pursue a teaching license in Ohio
- Are focused on teaching math or special education
- Are intending to attend Muskingum University
- Demonstrated commitment to the Appalachian region
- Agree to teach in the hiring Appalachian district for at least three years upon teaching degree and license attainment
