

Superintendent, Chief Academic Officer/Curriculum Director + Team of Educators

Purpose: The focus of this cohort will be to deepen understanding of 21st century learning design to empower district teams to **lead and support as influential ambassadors** in your system's transformation.

To accommodate the unique needs of districts, there will be varied pathways for professional, collaborative learning.

Through membership in the 21st Century Learning Design Network, leadership teams will:

- Learn within a statewide network committed to implementing 21st century learning experiences for every student.
- **Unpack** the district's vision for 21st century learning—Portrait of a Graduate—to inform the development of a system-wide instructional framework.
- **Build** leadership capacity to support teachers in designing and implementing deeper learning for all students.
- Assess system readiness to inform strategy and for monitoring progress.
- Support teachers in self-assessment and reflection.
- **Develop** balanced assessment strategies aligned to 21st century learning.
